Prompt #3: What is the significance of having a united, state-wide voice for JROTC in Alabama and what does it mean for the future of JROTC in Alabama?

- Picture of the cadet at the position of attention, facing the camera, in Class A uniform. (plain light-colored background) No faxed copies will be accepted.
- At least three letters of recommendation: one from the cadet's instructor, one from one of the cadet's current or past core subject teachers, and one more from a local leader (not a relative or school official).
